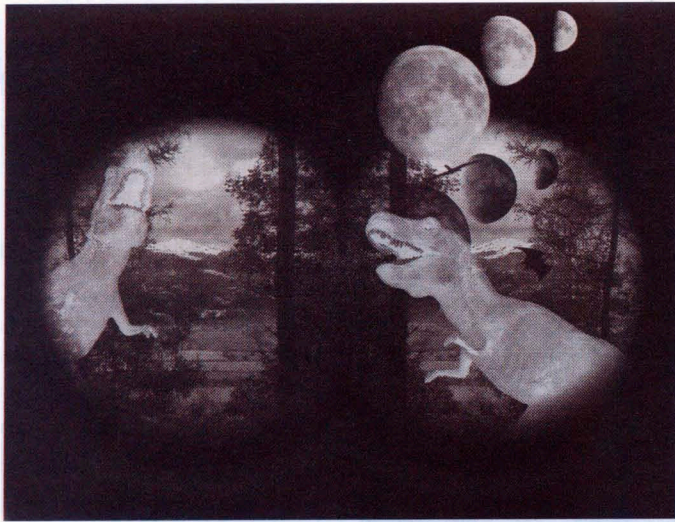

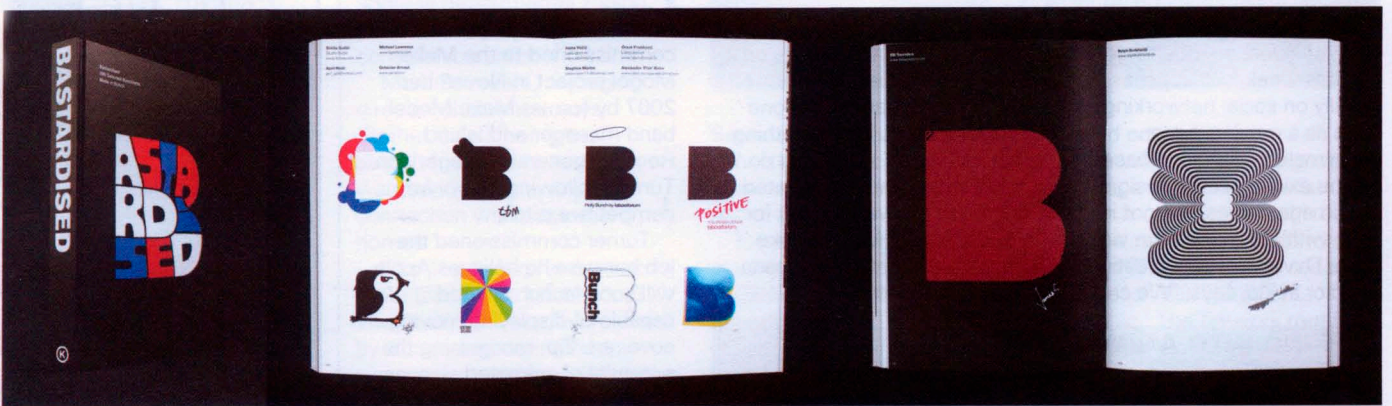


Ten-year journey

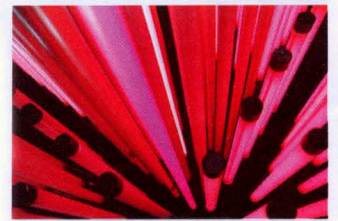
